TTD Annual Budget Approved

On March 8th, TTD's Annual Meeting of Electors was held in the community room of The Marvin. TTD Commission Chairman David Brown, Commissioners Charlie Yost and Debora Goldstein, TTD Treasurer Dr. Michael Intrieri, and TTD General Manager Jim Smith presided over the meeting. Michelle Maggio was elected Chairman of the meeting by voting attendees.

Dr. Intrieri delivered the District Year in Review, followed by an industry and legislative update from Commissioner Deborah Goldstein. Commissioner Yost presented the Library Vision and Commitment and Sarah Mann, President ENIA, presented the Library Budget.

General Manager Smith presented the financial report of the operation of the Electric Department for the fiscal year July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, and Chairman Brown presented the District Budget, both followed by Q&A from the public.

The District Budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 was unanimously approved by the voters with a vote of 33-0.



Reliability Excellence

Recently, TTD's efforts to provide sale and reliable power to the community of East Norwalk, were recognized by the American Public Power Association. APPA helps members track outage and restoration data through its subscription-based eReliability Tracker service and then compares the data to national statistics tracked by the U.S. Energy Information Administration for all types of electric utilities.

This year, TTD was awarded a Certificate of Excellence in Reliability for significantly outperforming the electric industry national average.
