The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Saturday, August 5, 2017 through Saturday, August 12, 2017

RAILROAD/LOCAL PROGRAM ACTIVITY

- Subsurface investigation work is anticipated to occur adjacent to the Walk Bridge east approach railroad tracks on Monday, August 7, 2017 from 8:00 AM-4:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail services or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- Subsurface monitoring work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the railroad tracks near Norden Place on Monday, August 7, 2017 from 9:00 AM-3:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- Surveying is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the Danbury Branch Dockyard railroad tracks on Monday, August 7 and Wednesday, August 9, 2017 from 8:00 AM-4:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
