The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Saturday, November 11, 2017 through Saturday, November 18, 2017

RAILROAD/LOCAL PROGRAM ACTIVITY

- Wire removal is anticipated to occur on the Danbury Branch Line, Friday, November 10 through Saturday, November 11, 2017 from 11:00 PM-6:00 AM. No impacts to local roads, rail service of pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- Mobilization of materials and equipment is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the Route 7 Southbound off-ramp to South Norwalk, Monday, November 13 through Friday, November 17, 2017 from 6:00 AM-4:00 PM. Right shoulder closure in effect on the Route 7 Southbound off-ramp to South Norwalk. [Map](#)
- Program team members are anticipated to be in the vicinity of the railroad tracks on Bridge Street, Tuesday, November 14, 2017 from 7:00 AM-4:00 PM for field observations. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated.
- Tree clearing work that may cause intermittent noise is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the Waste Water Treatment Facility on S. Smith Street, Monday, November 13 through Friday, November 17, 2017 from 8:00 AM-5:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- Aerial field observations are anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the Walk Bridge Replacement Project, Monday, November 13 through Friday, November 17, 2017 from 8:00 AM-5:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
