The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Saturday, December 2, 2017 through Saturday, December 9, 2017

RAILROAD ACTIVITY

- Preliminary excavation work for new catenary structures is anticipated to occur within the limits of the Danbury Branch Dockyard Project, Monday, December 4 through Friday, December 8, 2017 from 8:00 AM-4:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)
- Track removal work is anticipated to occur within the limits of the Danbury Branch Dockyard Project from the Ann Street railroad bridge to the I-95 underpass, Monday, December 4 through Friday, December 8, 2017 from 7:00 AM-4:30 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)

ROADWAY ACTIVITY

- Mobilization of materials and equipment is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the Route 7 Southbound off-ramp to South Norwalk, Monday, December 4 through Friday, December 8, 2017 from 6:00 AM-4:00 PM. Right shoulder closure in effect on the Route 7 Southbound off-ramp to South Norwalk. Please watch for the entering and exiting of construction equipment trucks. [Map](#)

- Aerial field observations are anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the Walk Bridge Replacement Project, Tuesday, December 5 through Thursday, December 7, 2017 from 8:00 AM-5:00 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated. [Map](#)

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The [Connecticut Department of Transportation \(CTDOT\)](#) is undertaking the Walk Bridge Program to replace the deteriorating railroad bridge over the Norwalk River in Norwalk, CT. One of the oldest movable bridges in the country, the Walk Bridge is a critical transportation link on the Northeast Corridor between Washington, D.C., New York City and Boston carrying four tracks of Metro-North Railroad, Amtrak and freight service.
