

Only a short walking distance from the East Norwalk Train Station, the two dual-head EV chargers are convenient for commuters as well as our East Norwalk residents on a daily basis.




Partnering with the Community

This refrigeration system senses interruptions in power supply which provides additional quality control measures such as preventing product spoilage.

Save with Rebates

There are a number of energy conservation and rebate programs available to TTD customers. Recently, new Connecticut Cool Choice Rebate forms have been added to the TTD website under **Programs**, including rebates for Commercial & Industrial Air Conditioners, Residential Air Conditioners, Attic Insulation and Heat Pump Water Heaters.
