In conjunction with Public Power Week, TTD partnered with Marvin Elementary School and presented two assemblies to grades K-5 on Friday, October 7th.

General Line Foreman Mike Adams, along with Utility Specialist Scott Tracy, Lineman Paul Hedrick, and General Manager Jim Smith treated the students to an interactive demonstration on electricity and safety.

The TTD team explained how electricity is provided to homes and

businesses, while displaying the various types of safety equipment worn and used by the lineman.

The program also included an outdoor demonstration, where the utility specialists constructed a “mock” power transmission model, including a utility pole, wires and a transformer.




Our New Look!
