Outage Notification Announcement

As part of on-going efforts to improve customer service and outage response systems, TTD is proud to announce that beginning August 1st, a new system will be used for handling outages after-hours, and on holidays and weekends.

When calling TTD to report an off-hours outage, you will be prompted to call **203-663-6875** and our outage notification team will handle your call immediately. This new system virtually eliminates the busy signal that some customers have experienced in the past. The "Report an Outage" feature on ttd.gov is still fully-functional for outage reports.

Commissioner Debora Goldstein played an instrumental role in developing this solution, working closely with TTD staff, Commissioners David Brown and Charlie Yost, and other partner companies, to ultimately make the system as customer-friendly as possible. Mike Adams, Promoted

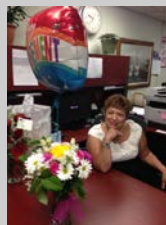
Mike Adams, a TTD lineman since 2008, was recently promoted to General Line Foreman. Look for a feature on Mike in the Oct/Nov newsletter.
