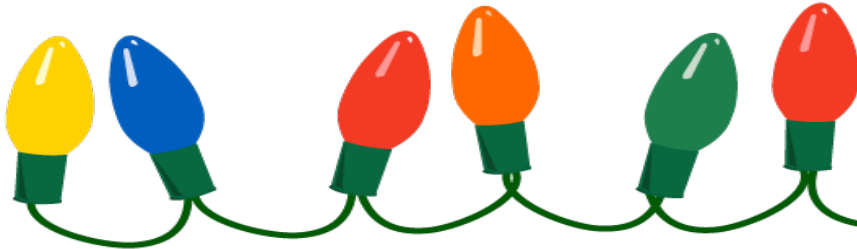

New Energy Saving Program

TTD customers are encouraged to call 877-878-3006 to schedule their FREE home energy assessment with LanternEnergy. The program is designed to help consumers save energy and cut costs. A certified technician will perform a full safety check, provide 4 complimentary CFL bulbs and 4 LED bulbs, and talk about available rebates. EV Charger Stations

TTD is excited to announce the installation of two dual-head EV Charger Stations at the East Norwalk Association Library on Van Zant Street. This project was made

possible, in part, by a grant from the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection.

East Avenue Substation Work

TTD's work on the East Avenue Substation Ground Grid is now complete. The new transformer is scheduled to be installed in Spring 2015.

Itron Meters

Installation of Itron meters is continuing throughout the district. As new meters are installed, TTD is also performing visual inspections of the meter outlets for any necessary repairs. If you have questions about meter installation, please contact TTD at 203-866-9271.

LED Streetlights

To date, TTD has installed over 300 LED streetlights, which covers about 38% of the district. Installation along Calf Pasture Beach Road has been completed, and Seaview Avenue is scheduled for completion in the near future.

Shorehaven Golf Club Project
