Thank you to all of our rate-payers for their ongoing support!

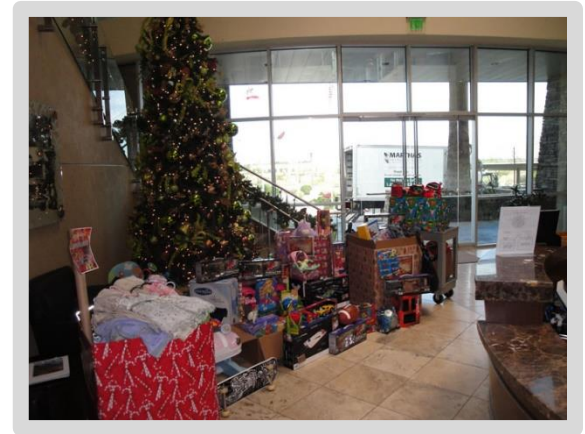
Spread Some Holiday Cheer

'Tis the Season

Tips to decorate safely:

- Look for broken or cracked sockets and frayed or bare wires. Recycle damaged light sets
- Keep ladders away from overhead power lines
- Only use electrical devices, cords and lights that are UL or FM approved
- String together no more than three light sets
- Keep paper and ribbon away from hot lights
- Unplug or shut off all decorative lights before bedtime or leaving home
- For better safety and energy savings, use LED lights
