GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Mr. Leary highlighted the financial projections. The Commissioners agreed that they did not want to raise their rates. They will discuss this further at the next meeting when they will know what the Norden payments will be from the ISO.

Mr. Leary said that the fuel charges have not changed since November 2008. Mr. Brown added that the basic charges have not changed in almost 30 years.

Mr. Leary said that the East Norwalk Improvement Association does not have liability insurance for parking.

Third Taxing District August 9, 2010 Page 1 of 3 Mr. Leary talked about the Economic Recovery Bonds project. He said that the State is short \$1 billion. He expressed concern about CL&P and United Illuminating wanting the Third Taxing District to participate in cost sharing. He will seek help from Mr. Duff and Mr. Perrone.

 - CONNECT POWER LINES TO TEMPORARY SERVICES (ABOUT 40) PRIOR TO THE EVENT AND DISCONNECT AFTER THE EVENT;
 - RELOCATE TRANSFORMER BANKS AND INDIVIDUAL TRANSFORMERS AS NEEDED;
 - TEMPORARY INSTALLATION, REMOVAL AND/OR ADJUSTMENT OF SECURITY LIGHTING;
 - DELIVER AND INSTALL FOUR (4) ALUMINUM AND FOUR (4) WOOD POLES FROM THE STORAGE AREA AND AFTER THE FESTIVAL REMOVE AND TRANSPORT THEM BACK TO THAT PROPERTY;
