



Walk Bridge Program CONSTRUCTION NEWS

Effective Friday, March 9, 2018

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Friday, March 9, 2018 through Monday, March 19, 2018.

RAILROAD ACTIVITY

- Track work is anticipated to occur on the Danbury Branch Line between the mainline wye and Jennings Place, Monday, March 12 through Friday, March 16, 2018 from 6:30 AM-3:30 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. Please watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles. - Track work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of Norden Place at night on Friday, March 16 through the morning of Sunday, March 18, 2018 from 10:00 PM-6:00 AM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. Intermittent noise and construction illumination are anticipated as a result of this work. [Map](#)
- Subsurface investigation work is anticipated to occur between the mainline wye and East Avenue at night, Monday, March 12 through the morning of Thursday, March 15, 2018 from 11:00 PM-4:00 AM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. Intermittent noise and construction illumination are anticipated as a result of this work. [Map](#)
- Subsurface investigation work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of the Ann Street Railroad Bridge at night on Friday, March 9 and through the morning of Sunday, March 11, 2018 from 10:00 PM-6:00 AM. Intermittent noise and construction illumination are anticipated to occur as a result of this work. [Map](#)

ROADWAY ACTIVITY

- A daytime road closure will occur on Ann Street to facilitate track work on the Ann Street Railroad Bridge, Monday, March 12 through Wednesday, March 14, 2018 from 7:30 AM-4:00 PM. Traffic will be detoured to Marshall Street and access to all properties will be maintained. [Map](#)
- A daytime lane closure will occur on Ann Street to facilitate installation of an overhead pedestrian protection system on Thursday, March 15 and Friday, March 16, 2018 from 7:30 AM-4:00 PM. Alternating one-way traffic and access to all properties will be maintained. A police officer will be on-site to facilitate traffic. [Map](#)

ADDITIONAL WORK ACTIVITIES

- Surveying activities are anticipated to occur in the vicinity of Norden Place on the south side of the railroad tracks, Wednesday, March 14 through Friday, March 16, 2018 from 8:30 AM-3:30 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. Please note, that construction personnel will be accessing the railroad track from Howard Avenue. [Map](#)

PLEASE BE ADVISED

- The SoNo Collection Mall project will be closing North Water Street between West Avenue and Oyster Shell Park starting January 24 through mid-April 2018 for construction. [Details](#)
- Work is weather permitting and will be rescheduled as necessary.
- Updates are provided weekly and any unforeseen schedule changes are updated on the Program website and social media.
- All local business access will be maintained.

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The [Connecticut Department of Transportation \(CTDOT\)](#) is undertaking the Walk Bridge Program to replace the deteriorating railroad bridge over the Norwalk River in Norwalk, CT. One of the oldest movable bridges in the country, the Walk Bridge is a critical transportation link on the Northeast Corridor between Washington, D.C., New York City and Boston carrying four tracks of Metro-North Railroad, Amtrak and freight service.
