



# Walk Bridge Program CONSTRUCTION NEWS

Effective Friday, May 11, 2018

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Friday, May 11 through Monday, May 21, 2018.

## RAILROAD ACTIVITY

- Track work is anticipated to occur on the Danbury Line, Monday, May 14 through Friday, May 18, 2018 from 6:30 AM-5:00 PM, between the mainline wye and Jennings Place. No impacts to local roads, rail service, or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. Please watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles. - Track work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of Norden Place, Monday, May 14 through Thursday, May 17 from 6:30 AM-3:30 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. [Map](#)
- Track work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of Norden Place during the nighttime hours, Tuesday, May 15 through the morning of Monday, May 21, 2018 from 10:00 PM-6:00 AM. Intermittent noise and construction illumination are anticipated as a result of this work. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. [Map](#)
- Bridge plate extensions are anticipated to be installed on the northbound track at the rail stations of East Norwalk, Westport and Green's Farms, Friday, May 18 at 10:00 PM and will be removed by the morning of Monday, May 21, 2018 at 6:00 AM. - Selective tree clearing work is anticipated to continue along the west side of the Danbury Line between Ann St. and N. 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The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) is undertaking the Walk Bridge Program to replace the deteriorating railroad bridge over the Norwalk River in Norwalk, CT. One of the oldest movable bridges in the country, the Walk Bridge is a critical transportation link on the Northeast Corridor between Washington, D.C., New York City and Boston carrying four tracks of Metro-North Railroad, Amtrak and freight service.
