



# Walk Bridge Program CONSTRUCTION NEWS

**Effective Friday, June 1, 2018**

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the following Walk Bridge Program activities for Friday, June 1 through Monday, June 11, 2018.

## RAILROAD ACTIVITY

- Track work is anticipated to occur on the Danbury Line, Monday, June 4 through Friday, June 8, 2018 from 6:30 AM-5:00 PM, between the mainline wye and Jennings Place. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. Please watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles. - Track work is anticipated to occur on the Danbury Line at night, Wednesday, June 6 through the morning of Monday, June 11, 2018 from 10:00 PM-6:00 AM, between the mainline wye and Jennings Place. Intermittent noise and construction illumination are anticipated as a result of this work. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. [Map](#)
- Track work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of Norden Place, Monday, June 4 through Friday, June 8 from 6:30 AM-3:30 PM. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. [Map](#)
- Track work is anticipated to occur in the vicinity of Norden Place during the nighttime hours, Monday, June 4 through the morning of Sunday, June 10, 2018 from 10:00 PM-6:00 AM. Intermittent noise and construction illumination are anticipated as a result of this work. Please note, an increased number of train horns will be heard as a result of this activity. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. [Map](#)

- Selective tree clearing work is anticipated to continue on the south side of the New Haven Line railroad tracks, west of Howard Avenue and progress towards Triangle Street, Monday, June 4 through Friday, June 8, 2018, from 8:00 AM-3:30 PM. Noise is anticipated as a result of this activity. No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated and access to all properties will be maintained. [Map](#)
- Rock grinding work is anticipated to occur on the south side of the New Haven Line railroad tracks, west of Howard Avenue and progress towards Triangle Street, Monday, June 4 through Friday, June 8, 2018 from 8:00 AM-3:30 PM. Please note, noise is anticipated as a result of this activity and construction vehicles will remove materials at night, between 10:00 PM-4:00 AM. [Map](#)
