Railroad Activity

Track work on the [Danbury Branch](#) between Marshall Street and Jennings Place

- Monday, December 31 and Wednesday, January 2 - Friday, January 4 from 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM
- No impacts to local roads or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Watch for the entering and exiting of construction vehicles
- Noise is anticipated

Signal house construction work on the New Haven Line between [N. Main Street and N. Water Street](#)

- Wednesday, January 2 - Sunday, January 6 from 6:30 AM - 3:30 PM
- Nighttime work may take place the weekend of Friday, January 4 - Sunday, January 6 from 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM pending Metro-North Railroad's operations
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated
- Property, business and residential access is maintained
- Noise and construction illumination are anticipated
