Agenda Item

A Discussion of Organizational Best Practices for Chief Financial Officer and General Counsel

Based on a recommendation made by the Special Committee, Ms. Kipnis explained that the Governance Committee tasked her with reviewing best practices for a reporting structure involving a dotted-line reporting of a General Counsel and a Chief Financial Officer to the Board of Directors of an organization.

She reviewed the organizational chart she created reflecting the dotted line reporting and that was provided to this Committee in advance of today's meeting.

Extensive discussion followed regarding the scope of the reporting structure of a CFO and General Counsel to the Board of Directors.

MECA David Silverstone added that as someone who has held the position of CEO in a similar industry it is important not to create an environment where the CEO's ability to run the organization is undermined. It was determined that Ms. Kipnis would attempt to codify the organizational chart in accordance with the discussion.

Given the lateness of the hour, the Committee agreed that it would table Agenda Items A-E until the next meeting scheduled for Thursday, August 15, 2019 at 1:00 p.m.
