Walk Bridge Program drainage upgrades are anticipated to resume on Goldstein Place in collaboration with the City of Norwalk's drainage improvements:

- 6:30 AM 4:00 PM.
- No weekend work.
- No impacts to local roads, rail service or pedestrian traffic are anticipated.

#### **About the Walk Bridge Replacement Project**

The Walk Bridge Replacement is part of the overall Walk Bridge Program consisting of more than a half-dozen interrelated road, rail, and utility infrastructure projects that enhance safety, reliability, and service flexibility throughout Norwalk. The replacement project was prompted by operational failures of the existing 124- year-old bridge leading to delays impacting thousands of passengers on the New Haven Line. The new bridge increases rail capacity and efficiency on the New Haven Line and Northeast Corridor (NEC) in addition to improving navigational capacity and dependability for marine traffic on the Norwalk River.

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
